Protest of Mercer-Fraser's Company's Bid

Dear Ms. Perez Hollins,

Pacific Infrastructure Construction, LLC (PIC) is formally protesting the bid submitted by Mercer-Fraser Company (MFC) on the above-mentioned contract. MFC's submitted bid has a material defect, making its bid nonresponsive. PIC, the now 2<sup>nd</sup> apparent low bidder, did submit a responsive bid and thus Caltrans should award the above contract to PIC.

# MFC's Bid is nonresponsive as it listed a Subcontractor to perform 50% of bid item 8 (Temporary Pavement Marking (Paint) however provided the description as "LCP For Stripe Removal

As required by the Contract 2024 Standard Specifications, Section 2-1 1.10 Subcontractor Listing requirements, "For each Subcontractor listed, the Subcontractor List form must show:

- 4. Portion of work it will perform. Show the portion of the work by:
  - 4.1 Bid Item numbers for the subcontracted work
  - 4.2 Percentage of the subcontracted work for each bid item listed
  - 4.3 Description of the Subcontracted work if the percentage of the bid item Listed is less than 100 percent"

MFC listed Nevada Barricade & Sign Company, INC. (NB) on their Subcontract Listing Form to perform Bid Item 8 for a percentage of 50 percent. MFC then provided a description for this work as "LCP For Stripe Removal" which is Bid Item No. 1's actual Description (See Exhibit A & B). By MFC listing a bid item with the incorrect description of work for its subcontractor (NB) it is unclear what work MFC will be self-performing. This improper listing does not comply with the Subcontracting Fair Practices Act (Pub Cont Code 4100 seq.), among other things. MFC's bid must be deemed nonresponsive based upon the above contract bid requirements.



To be responsive, a bid must be in strict and full accordance with the material terms of the Notice to Bidders. "A basic rule of competitive bidding is that bids must conform to the specifications, and that if a bid does not so conform, it may not be accepted." Ghilotti Const. Co. v. City of Richmond (1996) 45 Cal. App. 897, 904, quotation omitted; see Great West Contractors, Inc. v. Irvine Unified School Dist. (2010) 187 Cal. App. 4<sup>th</sup> 1425, 1456 (which recognized, "Literal noncompliance with a bid request...makes a bid nonresponsive."); see also Taylor Bus Service, Inc. v San Diego Bd. of Education (1987) 195 Cal. App.3d. 1331, 1341 (citation omitted) ("bid is only responsive, if it promises to do what the bidding instructions demand.")

Caltrans cannot waive the bid defects or irregularities found in MFC bid documents. The test of whether these defects can be waived pursuant to Section 1.46 of the Contract is set forth in Konica Business Machines v. Regents of the University of California (1988) 206 Cal. App. 3d 449, 454, 253 Cal Rptr. 591. Konica instructs that a defect cannot be waived if, (as applicable to MFC material deviation), it gave the bidder an advantage or benefit not available to other bidders. Caltrans has consistently ruled that the material defects in MFC's bid cannot be waived (Exhibit C) and thus, MFC's bid must be deemed as non-responsive nonresponsive bid.

# MFC only met 15.77% of the required 21% DBE goal. By failing to meet the specified DBE goal when it is clear that it was easily attainable, MFC's bid is nonresponsive

Both McCuen Construction, Inc. (MCI) and PIC met and exceeded the 21% required DBE goal for this project. From reviewing MFC's DBE Commitment Form it is apparent that MFC did not put forth a serious effort to meet this goal. MFC listed Roll 'N Rock Construction (RNR) for 80% of Bid Item 6 (Traffic Control). (see Exhibit D) If MFC was trying to meet the 21% DBE goal they would have listed RNR for 100% of this bid item. As seen on MCI's DBE Commitment Form and PIC's Commitment Form (Exhibit E) there was a substantial amount of DBE participation available by just having their electrical subcontractor buy the electrical materials from a DBE regular dealer (Over \$500,000.00) Also, there were many smaller DBE's firms that quoted this project that MFC decided not to use for some unknown reason. Clearly the 21% DBE goal for this project could have been met if MFC took a serious approach to meeting the DBE goal. For this reason, MFC's bid should be deemed nonresponsive.

In summary, based upon MFC's Subcontractors listing material error, Caltrans cannot determine what portion of work MFC will be performing on this Contract. A bid item description that is used to describe what portion of work a listed subcontractor is performing that is completely different from the actual bid item, is no different than a bidding contractor not listing any description of work for a bid item that is listed for less than 100 percent. Furthermore, MFC did not meet the required DBE goal for this project nor make a realistic attempt to meet the DBE goal. PIC requests Caltrans to award this Contract to PIC as PIC submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

Dear Mr. Fernadino,

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) received a letter dated November 15, 2024, Security Paving Company Inc. (Security Paving) for the above-referenced, federal-aid contract, claiming two inadvertent errors in its bid. Security Paving first alleges it listed Kie-Con as performing bid items 81-87 on its Subcontractor List form to furnish and erect precast concrete girders. When listing Kie-Con's registration numbers, Security Paving incorrectly listed 1000006274, which should have been 2000006274. Second, there were missing descriptions for bid items 163-166 on its Subcontractor List form, where Security Paving alleges it intended to list Dees Burke Engineering Contractors, LLC (Dees Burke), as indicated in its proposal to furnish and pour concrete barrier for bid items 162-171. By this letter, Caltrans notifies Security Paving that its bid is nonresponsive.

Caltrans refers Security Paving to Public Contract Code (PCC) section 4107.5 which states in part:

"The prime contractor as a condition to assert a claim of inadvertent clerical error in the listing of a subcontractor shall within two working days after the time of the prime bid opening by the awarding authority give written notice to the awarding authority and copies of that notice to both the subcontractor he or she claims to have listed in error and the intended subcontractor who had bid to the prime contractor prior to bid opening."

Caltrans reviewed Security Paving's inadvertent error letter and finds that although Security Paving submitted its letter on November 15, 2024, within two (2) days after bid opening and attempted to correct their bid claiming an error, the attempted correction would improperly modify the bid after the deadline of the bid opening date, which is not allowed.

With regards to the claimed "inadvertent error" of not listing the correct DIR number

for Kie-Con, Caltrans finds this deviation to be immaterial, as it would not grant Security Paving a competitive advantage over other bidders. Given the specific circumstances surrounding Security Paving's bid, Caltrans would waive this immaterial deviation from the bidding requirements.

However, the alleged inadvertent error regarding Security Paving's listing of Dees Burke for bid items 163-166 would constitute an improper modification of its bid after bid opening. Caltrans directs Security Paving to Section 2-1.10 of the 2023 Standard Specifications, Subcontractor List which states in part:

"On the Subcontractor List form, list each subcontractor that will perform work in an amount in excess of 1/2 of 1 percent of the total bid or \$10,000, whichever is greater (Pub Cont Code § 4100 et seq.). For each subcontractor listed, the Subcontractor List form must show:

- 4. Portion of work it will perform. Show the portion of the work by:
  - 4.1. Bid item numbers for the subcontracted work
  - 4.2. Percentage of the subcontracted work for each bid item listed
  - 4.3. Description of the subcontracted work if the percentage of the bid item listed is less than 100 percent "

Caltrans reviewed Security Paving's bid submittal and found that it listed Dees Burke to perform bid items 163-166 for less than 100 percent but failed to provide the descriptions of the work to be performed. As Security Paving did not comply with the above-stated specification or the corresponding Subletting and Subcontracting Fair Practices Act (Pub Cont Code § 4100 et seq.), its bid is nonresponsive.

Further, Security Paving, via its November 15 letter, is not attempting to correct the listing of a subcontractor but is instead attempting to modify the bid item of work that a listed subcontractor was set to perform (i.e., adding scope/the missing descriptions to bid items 162-166 that were listed under 100 percent). Given the specific circumstances of Security Paving's bid, Caltrans finds that allowing Security Paving to alter its bid after bid opening in such a way would go beyond the scope of an "inadvertent error" as set forth in PCC section 4107.5 and is not permitted by law. Therefore, Security Paving will not be granted the requested change to its bid and will be held to its initial bid submittal.

Based on the above, Caltrans will proceed to award the contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, provided that all requirements are met.

Dear Mr. Holmstrom,

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) received a letter dated February 2, 2024, from Ragnar Benson, LLC., (RBL) regarding its bid for the above-referenced federal aid contract. In its letter, RBL sought to correct one hundred-seventy-eight (178) separate bid items listed on its Subcontractor List form, as those bid items allegedly included an extra value of 100 to each bid item. (i.e., a "100, 200" value to the bid item numbers). By this letter, Caltrans notifies RBL requested post-bid modifications are not permissible, and its bid is nonresponsive because of inconsistencies between its Bid Item List and Subcontractor List form.

Caltrans has reviewed RBL's entire bid submittal, and finds that RBL submitted its letter on February 2, 2024, two days after bid opening, to correct all bid item numbers listed on its Subcontractor List form. Specifically, the letter seeks to correct bid items on its Subcontractor List form as follows: bid item numbers were listed with 3-digit entries by adding a value of 100 to each bid item number caused by RBL's bidding system default, except for bid Item 31 listed under Hydrosprout, Inc., which was apparently not listed in error.

Caltrans finds that although RBL submitted its letter claiming a system bidding error, the attempted corrections would modify its bid after the deadline of the bid opening date, which is not allowed. The requested modifications may provide RBL a competitive advantage, do not constitute an inadvertent clerical error, and run afoul of the Subletting and Subcontracting Fair Practices Act. (Pub. Contract Code, §4100, et seq.).

Caltrans refers RBL to Public Contract Code Section 4107.5 which states: "The prime contractor as a condition to assert a claim of inadvertent clerical error in the listing of a subcontractor shall within two working days after the time of the prime bid opening by the awarding authority give written notice to the awarding authority and copies of that notice to both the subcontractor he or she claims to have listed in error and the intended subcontractor who had bid to the prime contractor prior to bid opening." However, RBL is not attempting to correct the incorrect listing of a subcontractor but is instead attempting to modify numerous bid item numbers of work which it listed for several

subcontractors to perform, and therefore, there is no permissible "inadvertent clerical error" in RBL's bid that may be claimed.

As such, Caltrans reviewed RBL's bid submittal and determined that RBL's Subcontractor List form listed several bid item numbers that are not listed on the Bid Item List (any bid item above 178, which is the final bid item number on the Bid Item list).

Caltrans directs RBL to Section 2-1.10 of the 202 Standard Specifications Section which states in part: ""...list each subcontractor that will perform work in an amount in excess of 1/2 of 1 percent of the total bid or \$10,000, whichever is greater (Pub Cont Code § 4100 et seq.). For each subcontractor listed, the Subcontractor List form must show:

- 4. Portion of work it will perform. Show the portion of the work by:
- 4.1. Bid item numbers for the subcontracted work
- 4.2. Percentage of the subcontracted work for each bid item listed
- 4.3. Description of the subcontracted work if the percentage of the bid item listed is less than 100 percent" (emphasis added).

Here, the bid items inadvertently listed by RBL cannot be corrected. Further, given the specific circumstances surrounding RBL's bid and the extent of the errors claimed to be made in its bid, Caltrans finds that the variances between RBL's Bid Item List and Subcontractor List form may provide RBL with an unfair competitive advantage if permitted, and thus the variances are material. Therefore, Caltrans finds RBL's bid to be nonresponsive.

Caltrans will proceed to award the contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, provided that all requirements are met.
